


RECOVER USERNAME

1. Open a browser and go to the page <http://www.surgicalreview.org/>


2. Click the link "Register/Log In" on the top right of the page.




3. Click the link "CLICK HERE TO LOG IN (REGISTERED USERS)"



4. Click the link "Can't sign in?"



5. Select "Recover Username", enter the email address associated with your username, click "Recover".



RESET PASSWORD

1. Open a browser and go to the page <http://www.surgicalreview.org/>


2. Click the link "**Register/Log In**" on the top right of the page.




3. Click the link "**CLICK HERE TO LOG IN (REGISTERED USERS)**"



4. Click the link "**Can't sign in?**"




5. Select "Reset Password", enter your username and the associated email then click "Reset" to have a new password sent to you.



6. The new password will be sent to your username's associated email address. Please check your spam or junk folders in case it lands there. 
7. Open your email and copy the new password *exactly* as it appears. It is case sensitive and will contain a variety of characters which may include a period at the end. Everything to the right of the colon (:) is part of the password.
8. Return to the login screen and enter your username and new password in the corresponding fields and click "Sign In."



9. Once you've successfully logged in you will need to change your password to something easier to remember. Click the "User Profile" button on the top left of your account management home page:



10. Enter the password you just received in the "Current Password" field, then enter a new password of your choice in the "New Password" field. Re-enter the new password in the "Confirm Password" field.



11. Click "Update" on the bottom left side of the page.
